Preparing Your Pet for Their Kinesiology Session

To get the most out of your pet's session, please ensure the following beforehand:

- Your pet is fed, well-hydrated, and has had a walk (if a dog)
- They have access to water during the session
- You're in a quiet, private space where both of you feel relaxed

Ideally, choose a spot where your pet can lie down or nap if they wish

For online sessions, a **Microsoft Teams link** will be emailed to you prior to our appointment. Please allow up to **90 minutes** for the initial consultation.

What Is Pet Kinesiology?

Pet Kinesiology helps uncover imbalances or blockages within your pet's physical and energetic systems, in much the same way it does for humans. By energetically surrogating your pet, I can assess biological, physical, emotional, or energetic stressors that may be impacting their wellbeing.

For best results (whether the session is in person or online), I will be surrogating your pet's energy. This means I will connect with your pet energetically to receive biofeedback through my own body, allowing me to identify and address any imbalances. If we are meeting in person, having your pet in the same room helps maintain a clear energetic connection. For online sessions, it's ideal for your pet to be nearby or in gentle physical contact with you. All corrections are applied gently and non-invasively through me as the surrogate, ensuring a safe and supportive experience for your pet.

Corrections may include:

- Acupressure & meridian stimulation
- Neurovascular and neurolymphatic activation
- Emotional stress diffusion
- Chakra balancing & aura alignment
- Flower essence recommendations

Some corrections can also be applied directly to your pet if they are comfortable. Kinesiology works beautifully as a complementary therapy and can be used alongside conventional veterinary treatment to support your pet's healing and wellbeing.
